Guidelines for Snowmobile Use on Campus

While Northern Maine Community College encourages students to enjoy the great snowmobiling trails throughout Aroostook County, in order to ensure safety and to avoid disturbing students or our neighbors, the college has implemented the following guidelines:

- Campus residents must register their snowmobiles by completing the snowmobile/ATV vehicle registration form with at the College Business Office.
- Snow sledders must abide by the campus speed limit of 15 mph. Reckless speed or conduct will lead to having your snowmobile operation privileges being revoked and your snowmobile being banned from campus.
- Snowmobile operation must remain on established trails only. Go directly on/off campus. The field between Andrews Hall and Edgemont Drive is NOT a permitted area of operation other than to go directly on/off campus.
- Snowmobiles must be parked on the outdoor basketball court or at the north end of campus near the parking lots. Snowmobile trailers need to be stored in the maintenance area to avoid problems during snow removal.
- Snow sledders that create a disturbance, are excessively loud, or are reckless will be banned from campus operation.
- Due to safety concerns, snowmobiles are NOT permitted on campus roadways or walkways.
- All campus snowmobiles need to be registered in the residential life office.
