The admissions process includes the following:

1. *Personal interview*
2. *Valid Maine driver's license and a review of driving record to determine eligibility*
3. *Pre-entrance FMCSA controlled substance test; verified negative results required*
4. *DOT physical, in accordance with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations with qualification verified*
5. *High School Diploma, GED or HiSET*
6. *Immunization record with proof of:*
 - *MMR or titer indicating immunity*
 - *Diphtheria/tetanus given within the past 10 years*
