# NMCC Guidelines for Snowmobile Use on Campus

While Northern Maine Community College encourages students to enjoy the great snowmobiling trails in Aroostook County, in order to ensure safety and to avoid disturbing students or our neighbors, the college has implemented the following guidelines:

Snow sledders must abide by the campus speed limit of 15 mph. Reckless speed or conduct will lead to having your snowmobile operation privileges being revoked and your snowmobile being banned from campus.

Snowmobile operation should be on established trails. Go directly on/off campus. The field between Andrews Hall and Edgemont Drive is NOT a permitted area of operation other than to go directly on/off campus.

Snowmobiles must be parked on the outdoor basketball court or at the north end of campus near the parking lots. Snowmobile trailers need to be stored in the maintenance area to avoid problems during snow removal.

Snow sledders that create a disturbance, are excessively loud, or are reckless will be banned from campus.

Due to safety concerns, snowmobiles are NOT permitted on campus roadways or walkways.

Thank you for snowmobiling in a safe manner that does not disturb other students on campus.
