Academic Skills Testing

As part of the admissions process to Northern Maine Community College, applicants are asked to complete or otherwise provide academic test scores to assist in placement decisions. Acceptable tests include:

- Accuplacer (Arithmetic, Elementary Algebra, Reading Comprehension and Sentence Skills)
- SAT (Critical Reading, Mathematics and Writing)
- ACT (English, Mathematics, Reading and Science)

Any student having completed this testing may have their high school or test administrator forward scores to the NMCC Admissions Office (fax: 207-768-2848 or email: admissions@nmcc.edu) for consideration.

Those applicants not providing academic skills test information will be scheduled to take the Accuplacer test on the day of their admission interview (or by appointment). Individuals requesting disability-related accommodations must do so prior to the test date by calling the NMCC Counseling Office at (207) 768-2839. Appropriate documentation is required.

It is strongly recommended that students prepare for the test before taking it. Our experience indicates that students who have prepared perform much better.
