**Filing Requirements for Most People**

**Table 1-1. 2015 Filing Requirements for Most Taxpayers**

<b>IF your filing status is...</b>	<b>AND at the end of 2015 you were...*</b>	<b>THEN file a return if your gross income was at least...**</b>
single	under 65	\$10,300
	65 or older	\$11,850
married filing jointly***	under 65 (both spouses)	\$20,600
	65 or older (one spouse)	\$21,850
	65 or older (both spouses)	\$23,100
married filing separately	any age	\$ 4,000
head of household	under 65	\$13,250
	65 or older	\$14,800
qualifying widow(er) with dependent child	under 65	\$16,600
	65 or older	\$17,850

***If your parent (or someone else) can claim you as a dependent use the following information to see if you must file a return.***

**Dependent—single and under 65 (most students)**

You must file a return if **any** of the following apply:

- Your **unearned** income was over \$1,000.
- Your **earned income** was over \$6,100.
- Your **gross income** was more than the larger of -
  - \$1,000, **or**
  - your **earned income** (up to \$5,750) plus \$350.
