A Multiple Case Study of the Students Perceptions of Mental Health at Three Maine Community Colleges



The purpose of the proposed multiple case study is to develop an understanding of community college students perceptions of mental health services. The practices of community college currently enrolled students expressed in this study will ideally supply information that will further allow practitioners, administration, or higher education interventionists to develop improved policies and practices that address the mental health of individuals at the student levels amongst community colleges.
